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Learning Objective To draw the image of the furniture before creating the furniture layers. Like most of the other tasks in this book, Photoshop has a special shortcut to perform this step that is useful to remember. To photograph your physical items, follow these steps: 1. **Open a new file in Photoshop CS5.** 2. **Click File** ⇒ **Open** (Windows) or Photoshop ⇒ Open (Mac). Navigate to the location of the image you want to use as the background and, if necessary, right-click and select Open. If you are using a scanned image, drag the image into the document window. If you are using a photographic image, find the actual image on your computer's hard drive and drag it into the Photoshop document window. (See Chapter 10 for how to add an image.) 3. **Click the Background layer to make it active.** 4. **Click Crop.** The Crop dialog box opens and may be slightly different from the one shown in Figure 12-6. 5. **Enter an area within the image to crop.** The crop box opens automatically at the center of the image, as shown in Figure 12-6, but you can easily drag the box to a different area of the image. 6. **Close the crop box.** 7. **Click OK.** 8. **Click Image** ⇒ **Adjustments.** The Adjustments panel opens, as shown in Figure 12-7. Since images are usually made out of PNG and JPG format, you will need to convert them to PSD to be able to edit them in the Adobe Photoshop software. Having them in PSD files also makes the images scalable as you can change the sizes of the images without loss of quality or detail. You can also add multiple image layers within PSD files. When you save your edited images in PSD format, you can choose PNG or JPG. Public health officials in the US have advised limiting the use of chelation therapy for lead poisoning because they say the evidence is not conclusive and the therapy may cause harm, including muscle weakness. Now, the American Association of Poison Control Centers has adopted a new position statement on the subject. It acknowledges the need for ongoing research to determine the effectiveness of the therapy, but says it "should not be considered a first-line therapy to address poisoning or exposure to lead." The position is aimed at clinicians and states they are not to prescribe it for acute lead poisoning. The recommendation is based on "the evidence-based principles that defined the last century's fight to eliminate the use of mercury and thimerosal," wrote Linda Dillingham, the chair of the AACAC science board. Last month the US National Institutes of Health, which funds the poison centers, asked experts to identify the best clinical evidence of chelation therapy's effectiveness for lead poisoning. The result is an eight-page summary. There is "a paucity of evidence" to support its use, since studies of the treatment are few, according to the summary, and the number of patients treated is too small to make firm conclusions. Chelation therapy has been used for decades, and it involves binding heavy metals like lead in the blood so they can be excreted, usually through the urine. It's thought to work by creating a soluble chelate so the metals can be eliminated from the body. The therapy was introduced in the US in the 1950s and is widely used in other countries. But in the US, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommended in 2003 that chelation therapy should only be used to treat serious lead poisoning, when the benefits and risks could be considered. And since then, about 100 patients have been treated in the US. That's not to say that chelation therapy doesn't work, says Dr Phil Landrigan, director of the Boston-based Preventive Medicine and Chief Medical Officer of the Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York City. A cross-sectional study was conducted to establish the prevalence of hepatitis A infection in a rural population in northern Taiwan. Serum was analyzed from a population-based cross-section of 1,823 subjects, 509 of whom were children aged 6 to 14 years. The prevalence of acute hepatitis A infection in this sample was 2.7 per 1,000 children. The mean age of the infected group was about 6 years. The 1-month, 1-week, and 1-day prevalence was 0.2% for the 6- to 14-year-olds, 1.4% for the 15- to 19-year-olds, and 2.3% for the 20- to 49-year-olds, respectively. This is the first community-based study in Taiwan to indicate a low prevalence of hepatitis A infection in the population at an early age. Doxepin-induced changes in serum levels of steroid hormones in women with premature ejaculation. The aim of our study was to examine effects of doxepin on the serum levels of steroid hormones in women with ejaculatory dysfunction. Ten non-pregnant women aged 19-29 years were given doxepin (10 mg) daily for 5 weeks. Plasma levels of free testosterone, dihydrotestosterone, 5 alpha-dihydrotestosterone, estradiol, progesterone, FSH, LH, prolactin, and TSH were measured at the beginning and at the end of treatment. After 5 weeks of treatment, doxepin reduced the total and free testosterone levels significantly. Progesterone, FSH, and LH did not change significantly during treatment. Dihydrotestosterone levels were slightly reduced during treatment. The changes in the levels of TSH and prolactin were not significant.
